

Svētā Jāņa Palīdzība Latvia Activity Report 2020/2021

Home care

In the service provision, 280 specially trained caregivers are employed. At present, the Association provides home care services to more than 800 clients. The Association has a cooperation agreement with Riga City Municipality and the service is financed by Riga City Municipality.

Day Care Centres

Day Care Centre for people with mental disorders. The Day Care Centre is attended by 35 people every day from 9.00 to 17.00.

Two Day Care Centres for people with dementia. Both Day Care Centres are attended by 50 people every day from 9.00 to 17.00.

Summer season Day Care Centre for children with disabilities.

The Day Care Centre is attended by 20 children every day from 9.00 to 17.00. The Association has a cooperation agreement with Riga City Municipality and the services are financed by Riga City Municipality.

Specialised workshops

Specialised workshops for people with mental disorders are attended by 15 clients.

The Association has a cooperation agreement with Riga City Municipality and the service is financed by Riga City Municipality.

Specialised patient transport

The Association has 5 specially equipped buses for transporting people with disabilities. The Association has a cooperation agreement with Riga City Municipality and the service is financed by Riga City Municipality.

Family assistants

The family assistant service provides a person (family) with support and assistance in solving housing, employment, education, addiction and health problems, development of social and household skills as well as child care and upbringing.

Personal assistant service for persons with disabilities

The personal assistant service for persons with disabilities provides physical and informative support to persons who due to physical or mental disorders, have difficulty moving outside the home, visiting state or municipal institutions and organisations for solving household issues, as well as health care service providers.

Humanitarian aid

In the warehouse of our humanitarian aid centre, goods are sorted and start their journey to the people who need them.

Soup kitchen

The soup kitchen service has been provided since 1991. An average of 500 servings of warm soups are served daily.

Catering service for the destitute and low-income

During Covid -19, we have opened 2 more catering points in Riga, where destitute and low-income families from Riga can get a warm lunch for free.

The Association has a cooperation agreement with Riga City Municipality and the service is financed by Riga City Municipality.

Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived

The Svētā Jāṇa Palīdzība Association provides activities to be supported within the framework of the Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived. On 25 March 2021, the Svētā Jāṇa Palīdzība Association and the Society Integration Foundation (SIF) signed an agreement (identification number: 2020.FEAD/PO.04/28/23) on the implementation of activities supported under the Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived for the next period: from 01.04.2021 to 31.03.2024.
