# Brussel, May 2023

#### National activities:

## Emergency response after earthquake in Turkey

- Hot meals and mobile food distribution
- Distribution of Hygiene Kits
- 44,000 people reached in Turkey

## Emergency response after earthquake in Syria

- Distribution of hot meals to 1,000 people in the region around Afrin
- Distribution of building materials
- Five hospitals will receive fuel for generators and ambulances to facilitate the provision of medical care.
- Through our partner (BAHAR) 600 families receive cash to buy needed supplies at the local markets

### **Emergency response in Ukraine**

- Over 1,000 tons of relief supplies have been sent to Ukraine, Romania, Moldova and Hungary with over 100 trucks.
- EUCC deliveries of rescEU funded protective equipment
- More than 40 medical facilities across the country have been supplied with medical drugs and supplies worth over € 900,000
- Johanniter Hungary received support to provide small relief transports to Ukraine and to provide shelter to refugees from Ukraine



- Several passenger and ambulance vehicles were donated to partners in Ukraine and Johanniter supported the purchase of two fire engines for the city of Kyiv

# Emergency Response in other East European countries and support for international displaced persons

- Romania: procurement of medical supplies, food items, medication and hygiene items
- Moldova: care for 2,200 refugees in temporary reception centres, improving temporary accommodations and supporting host families. Also distribution of daily meals to 200 refugees in temporary reception centres and psychosocial services as individual and group offers.
- Support for Johanniter Hungary: donation of bed and kitchen appliances for nine emergency shelters near the border.
- Project Rhodes: implemented by Malteser international with Malteser Ukraine and support of Johanniter international Assistance. Procurement of three vehicles, converted into social mobiles for children and used for child welfare and psychosocial activities.
